This is not a lifetime achievement award and all nominations should reflect activities within the recent past. The Award will be presented for recent achievements. Service Provider of the Year Award

The Award is presented to a service provider or team that, through development and innovation of the services it provides, has significantly contributed to more efficient or effective exploration, or improvements in mining operations in the province.

The Award will be presented for recent achievements. Nominations will be valid for two years.

Geoscientist of the Year Award

The Award is presented to a geoscientist or team whose work in the province is in use, and has contributed significantly to either: improved regional or detailed exploration models or techniques; a new mineral discovery; or a significant expansion to a known ore body in the province.

The Award will be presented for recent achievements. Nominations will be valid for two years.
