



Rory Kempster Memorial Earth Science Scholarship

The New Brunswick Branch of the Canadian Institute of Mining, Metallurgy and Petroleum (CIM-NB) invites applications for the **\$2,000** Rory Kempster Memorial Earth Science Scholarship tenable at a degree granting Canadian University or Institute of Technology from students meeting our eligibility requirements:

- Entering second or subsequent years of study leading to the first degree in an earth science discipline (geology, mining, metallurgy, petroleum, geochemistry, etc.)
- Interested in a career in the earth sciences.
- Scholastic ability/achievement.
- Financial need.
- Interests outside of earth science.
- Born in New Brunswick or resided in New Brunswick for a minimum of five years or have immediate family residing in New Brunswick.

Applications must include the following information:

1. Name, address, telephone number, email.
2. Current educational institution, major field of study, year of study, expected year of graduation.
3. Need for financial support and present means of support. This must include any past and present scholarships or awards (years and amounts).
4. Statement describing your career goals (maximum 250 words).
5. Description of your interests and involvement outside Earth Science. This may include, but is not limited to, community, academic, volunteering, accomplishments, and self-interests (maximum 250 words).
6. Letter of recommendation from a faculty member or former employer in the professional designations of earth science or engineering.
7. Most recent transcript (unofficial) of university courses and grades.
8. Any additional information you feel would be relevant.

Applications must be submitted to newbrunswick@cim.org by May 31st, 2022.
