The CIM Foundation (CIMF) is committed to ensuring a strong future for the mining and metallurgical industries through incentives to support and promote education. In an effort to encourage young people to pursue careers in mining and related industries, CIMF is offering the Jim Popowich Memorial Mining Endowment - Geology Scholarship.

The CIMF is offering one \$3,000 award to an outstanding undergraduate student in their 3rd year, studying geology in Canada. Only Canadian students are invited to apply. Applications must be submitted by April 30. The scholarship recipient will be announced in July and the scholarship will be awarded in September providing the candidate remains active and enrolled in their faculty's geology program. An announcement about the recipient will appear in *CIMF Newsletter* and website.

Eligibility

Recipients are selected on the basis of eligibility and must be enrolled fulltime and currently completing their third year of an eligible undergraduate university program in geology in Canada. The scholarship is open to Canadian students.

Qualifications

Applicants will be judged on academic achievement, practical experience and a commitment to a career in the mining industry.

Application Requirements

Complete application packages must be submitted by **April 30** and include:

- The application form
- Letter of referral from a professor
- Essay describing how you are preparing yourself for a career in geology (maximum 400 words)
- Resume (curriculum vitae)
- A copy of your current academic transcript (can be unofficial)
- A confirmation of enrollment to your program

Application Procedure

To apply for a scholarship, Canadian students enrolled in an undergraduate program in a Canadian university, and in their 3rd year of a geology program must submit a package by April 30, including:

- The application form
- Letter of referral from a professor
- Essay describing how you are preparing yourself for a career in geology, including practical experience (maximum 400 words)
- Resume (curriculum vitae)
- A copy of your current academic transcript (can be unofficial)
- A confirmation of enrollment to your program

All of this information will be considered by the CIMF Scholarship Committee when they make their selection. While academic achievement is important, submissions should demonstrate a keen interest in geology, as well as describe the candidate's problem-solving skills, ability to work in a challenging environment, as well as experience working within organized teams, all in the context of both a university and work setting.

One scholarship is to be awarded annually. All qualifying scholarship applicants will receive a complimentary CIM student membership.

This Scholarship was established by Laverne Popowich, and is administered by the CIM Foundation.
